Announcement of the Max Fabiani Award

The Town and Spatial Planning Association of Slovenia (TSPAS), in collaboration with the Max Fabiani Foundation, Ministry of Culture and Ministry of the Environment and Spatial Planning of the Republic of Slovenia,

announces a call for the

International Max Fabiani Award for 2005–2015 achievements

for exceptional work in urban design, urban planning, regional planning, or spatial planning carried out in Slovenia and neighboring Austria, Italy, Croatia, and Hungary.

Individuals and groups may enter the following works into the competition (participation eligibility):

- Projects and studies in urban design, urban planning, regional planning, or spatial planning (architectural projects will not be accepted);
- Projects and studies that were carried out, planned, or created between 2005 and 2015;
- Projects and studies that were carried out, planned, or created in Slovenia or neighboring Austria, Italy, Croatia, and Hungary;
- Projects that were carried out or prepared in the form of urban/spatial plans;
- Studies published in research journals or volumes.

Participation requirements:

- Individuals and groups entering the competition must pay an entry fee of €150 for each work; this covers only the necessary costs of the jury and final ceremony, printing, and preparation for display;
- The entry fee should be paid to the TSPAS bank account:

- Confirmation of payment must be sent by e-mail before or at the same time that the competition work is submitted;
- Each individual or group may send only two works.

Technical requirements for preparing works:

- The works should be presented on two A1 (594 × 841 mm) posters. They should incorporate a presentation of the location and the entire work, and they should be well illustrated with a short description of the project or study in English. Photos of projects carried out are necessary.
- Candidates must also present a written explanation of the work on a maximum of two A4 pages in English and complete the QUESTIONNAIRE (at the end of this Announcement).
- Posters should be designed using the templates and fonts available at the website www.dupps.si.
- It is not necessary to send printed posters by mail, but a digital version by e-mail or on a CD/DVD must be submitted. Digital material should contain:
 - A press-quality PDF file of posters (CMYK, image resolution 300 dpi)
 - A JPEG version of posters (1240 × 1754 pixels, RGB)
 - A text file with a written explanation (DOC or RFT)
 - Proof of entry fee payment
- Entries not meeting these specifications will be excluded from the competition.

Conferral of award and special commendations

- One International Max Fabiani Award and three (maximum) Special Commendations will be conferred.
- The selection will be made by an international jury by October 15th, 2015.
- The award includes a sculptural installation (a work by the prominent Slovenian graphic designer Eduard Čehovin) and a certificate. The prize will not be a financial one.
- The ceremony will take place on or about October 24th, 2015 in Štanjel, Slovenia.

Presentation of winning projects and other projects

- All works received will be presented at an exhibition at Štanjel Castle and tentatively later in Ljubljana, Slovenia.
- Selected works will be announced in international media.

Explanation of the award

The International Max Fabiani Award is announced in honor of 150th anniversary of the birth of this prominent architect and urban planner from Slovenia's Karst region. Max Fabiani was not only an exceptional architect, urban planner, and researcher in architecture at the urban and regional levels, but also authored professional and philosophical texts. His work was exceptional and influential before and after the First World War in Austria-Hungary, Italy, the former Yugoslavia, Slovenia, and other central European countries.

The roots of his artistic oeuvre are in the Austro-Hungarian Secession, followed by functionalistic orientations and concepts, especially in his urban plans. His visionary projects for regional plans are among the beginnings of regional studies at the global level. He was one of the few architects in the monarchy (and the first one) to be awarded an honorary doctorate.

We confer the Max Fabiani Award in commemoration of his exceptional work in urban design, urban planning, and regional planning. The award is intended particularly for these domains.

The award is already well known as a biennial award conferred since 2005, but to date it has been conferred only for projects in Slovenia.

You are invited to compete for this prestigious award, which will enhance the profile and international recognition of your achievements.
