The topic of the seminar will be: **Spatial Development Visions: Water Space Planning**. The meeting will be partly devoted to the 150th anniversary of the birth of urbanist and architect professor Max Fabiani, as one of the events commemorating the Fabiani year 2015. The proposals made by Fabiani regarding regulation of cities and waterways were farsighted and are still relevant today. This is also evident from the Regulation plan for the post earthquake renewal of the city of Ljubljana from 1895, in which Fabiani proposed the city ring, completed with the bridge on Roška road (Fabiani's bridge), just recently.

In the memory of Maks Fabiani we are going to emphasize his urban planning, especially his water regulations. On the same note we are going to discuss the current topic of planning waterways and river banks. We will also highlight the hazard that floods pose to Slovenia and the necessity of building counter flood measures. This is one of the 22 projects of the Operational Programme for the Implementation of the EU Cohesion Policy 2014-2020: Investments to reduce flood risk in Slovenia.

We will mention Fabiani's boldness in planning the transport waterway – channel, that would connect the northern Adriatic to the Danube near Bratislava and make a correlation to the challenges regarding waterways and water spaces in general, which we are faced with today.
